READING AND HOMEWORK

Reading: We ask that children read at home to an adult at least 4 times a week - this is to be recorded in their reading log, signed by an adult and handed in every Monday.

English/ SPaC: This will be set on a Monday and needs to be handed in the following Monday. It will include practice of the weekly spellings as well as focusing on the revision of a skill taught in our writing lessons.

Maths: This will be set on a Friday and needs to be handed in the following Friday. This will consist of times tables and division facts for year 4 and revision of learning taught in class for year 5/6. It is really important that your child completes their set homework on time and that they bring it in on the correct day. If you find your child is finding the homework particularly difficult please let us know and we can address this.
