

English:

We will start by focussing on nouns and verbs before immersing ourselves in our class text and writing stories. We will then move on to write non-chronological reports, setting descriptions and diaries. We will finish the term with a focus on poetry and play scripts.

MFL:

Mrs. Wilson will teach a weekly French lesson with a focus on key vocabulary.

Music:

This term we will have a specialist music teacher joining us to teach us how to play the recorder.



Art/ DT:

The use of sketching pencils and charcoal to create Antarctic animals. A study of the illustrator William Grill. We also have 'MADE' joining us who will be working on art projects throughout the term.

RE:

- What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving?
- Why do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah?

Maths:

This term will focus on place value and calculations using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also continue to practise times tables and mental arithmetic skills daily.

History/ Geography:

We will learn about the polar regions and the similarities and differences between them. Map work will involve locating places and identifying latitude, longitude and the equator. We will learn about Ernest Shackleton the Antarctic explorer and his expedition on the Endurance as a significant figure.
