I love our photos in this week's newsletter; they show off our authentic learning superbly as we create real opportunities for our children to apply their learning. You can see this really well in Nanjizal's science experiment, Gwenver's dinosaur egg making and Porthcurno's work with Cape Cornwall School in Geography this week. There will be more evidence in all of this as classes host their end of term 'showcases' next week. Look out for your children bringing home information regarding this; our Friends of the School will be serving teas, coffees and cakes for a small donation during these showcases too.

As you may be aware, from today (Friday 1st April), there are some new regulations around COVID. Adults who test positive for COVID-19 should try to stay at home and avoid contact with people for 5 days. For children or young people (anyone under the age of 18), they should do the same but for 3 days. Therefore, if your child tests positive, please follow this new guidance. If you, or whoever may drop-off or collect your child, tests positive, then please let us know so that we can make arrangements with you to ensure drop-off and collection times are carried out safely and effectively.

On drop-off and collection, can we please remind you that if someone who does not normally collect your child, or in the event of them going home with somebody else, is due to pick your child up on a given day, then please make us aware beforehand.

Please remember to park with consideration to our families and neighbours. If you witness someone who isn't parked as per guidance, then please notify the school - thank you.

Please do continue to bring in Easter Eggs or treats for the Friends of the School ahead of their raffle next week.

Lastly, this week we appointed Mrs Ayotte as our new teacher within Porthcurno Class. We are really excited for Mrs Ayotte to join our team after Easter. Initially, to help support transition for our children, she will be working Friday only with Mrs Rendle teaching them Monday to Thursday. From May half-term Mrs Ayotte will teach Thursday and Fridays, as per our current structure.

As you know, Mrs Wilson will continue with running our Forest School sessions an afternoon a week for the remainder of the school year. However, I am delighted to let you know that from next year Mrs Wilson will still be with us leading our Forest School sessions to all of our children throughout the school and working in each class teaching French too! Although it is not compulsory for French to be taught in Reception or Key Stage 1, we feel that it adds value to our school offer, as does our Forest School for all.

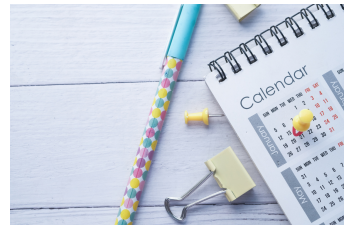

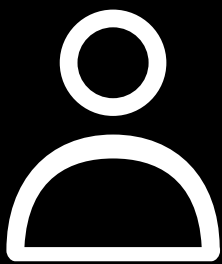

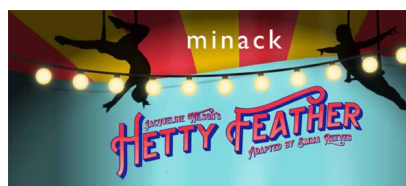
