We appreciate that there are some enforced changes that mean we have to manage some things differently, please understand that any decision made has the safety and well-being of the school community at the heart of it.

At the end of last term I updated you of our decision to join a Multi-Academy Trust (MAT). We are set to join LEAP (Leading Edge Academy Partnership) in October and we are really excited about the venture. It will mean us working with local, like-minded schools and will allow us to continue furthering ourselves and the opportunities we are able to offer the children of St Buryan.

We are now able to provide fruit to our Key Stage 1 children again, so they no longer need to bring their own snack in. Key Stage 2 children are still welcome to bring in their own healthy snack. We do request that they do not bring any items of food that contain nuts for their healthy snack. Thank you.


