*Our KS2 (Y6) results were published this week; we are delighted to announce that our percentage pass rate for each of the 3 areas was 72%. This year's National figures are still in the process of being collated but if we refer to last year's National average pass rate of 51% our scores represent a very positive picture.*

*Congratulations to all our Y6s who worked so hard for these statutory tests and staff who supported them so well. We continue to emphasize that, while these tests indicate a child's academic performance and progress, we value equally the individual talents of every child in every year group. There has doubtless been an over-emphasis on academic achievement over past years; hopefully our ongoing work concerning the Virtues Project will help our children develop into confident, resilient characters who continue to develop a love of learning. As a school we will continue to value the things which tests don't measure.*
