Let's hear it for our Year 6s!

We are beyond proud of them for what they have had to do this week. After two years of no SATs, they were re-introduced to our school calendar for this year! Children's Key Stage 2 SATs are designed to be a culmination of their learning throughout the key stage: from Year 3 to Year 6. As you all know, our current Year 6 have had two core years of that time disturbed by school closures and everything else that the pandemic threw at them and us all. So, to approach them in the positive way that they did, to put in the hard-work to ensure that they were well prepared and for just having positive attitudes about the whole thing is so commendable and we are extremely proud of them. 
