I am sure that everyone joins me in wishing them luck and I am sure they will all do really well!

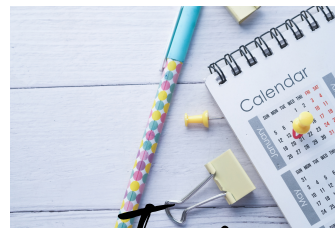

Trying your best, giving 100% are important, as it is to keep smiling and being positive about your own individual achievements; no matter what area they may be in. I think we all feel for our year 6s, their SATs are meant to be a culmination of their learning in Key Stage 2 (years 3-6), and to have the disruption they have over the past three years and now have to sit these next week seems unfair. That being said, I am incredibly proud of them for their hard work, positivity, ambition and desire to achieve; as I am with all our children and I'm sure that we all are.

Next week we are also involved in the St Buryan Feast; it is great to see this up and running again and I am sure that they would be extremely grateful for your support next week. Although we won't be involved 'in person' over the weekend of the Feast, our children will be creating art work for display based on the theme of the Jubilee. Another community event we look forward to being back involved with is the Horticulture Show. Although this doesn't take place until later in July, children have taken home plants tasked with the challenge to help them survive and flourish. They will need to return these to school in the last week of term. Even if your child ends up not taken part in the show or submitting their plant, it is still a great project to take part in and to watch their own plant - something that they are responsible for - grow with their care and nurture.

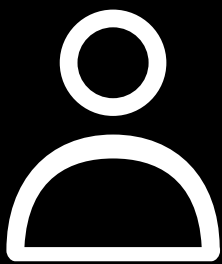
