Re-opening of school

We will be phasing our reopening in order to facilitate the safest and smoothest transition back to school for our children.

From June 1st we welcome back our Key Worker children.

From June 8th we welcome back our Year 6 children.

From June 15th we welcome back our Year 1 children.

From June 22nd we welcome back our Reception children.

We await further guidance on the return for all year groups.

Timing of the school day

We will be shut on Wednesday and Friday afternoons for deep cleans. On these days Reception and Year 1 children should be collected at 1.15pm; Key Worker and Year 6 children should be collected at 1.30pm.

Key Worker children should arrive at school at 8.55am and may stay on the playground with a teacher.

-Year 6 children must go straight to class entering only through the side door which they use for break times. They should arrive at 9.00am.

-Year 1 and Reception children should arrive at 9.00am and may stay on the playground with their teacher.

-Other than Wednesdays and Fridays, mentioned above, the school finishing times will be as follows:

- Key Worker children will finish at 3.15pm

- Year 6 children will finish at 3.10pm

- Reception and Year 1 children will finish at 3.00pm

Uniform and equipment

Children will need to bring minimal equipment from home. They will not need stationary or PE kits.

Children will not have to wear school uniform, although we do ask that they bring a school jumper/fleece/cardigan with them. Children should wear appropriate clothing for school and dress for crafts and outdoor learning. Clean clothing should be worn each day.

All children should bring a named water bottle to school. No jewellery should be worn.

Before the school day

Before each day please ensure that your child's hands are washed and clean. Should they show any of the recognised symptoms of COVID:19 then please keep them off school. If a child shows any signs of illness we will ring and they must be collected immediately.

We also ask for everyone to be aware of the new track and trace guidance and that it is adhered to.

We also ask that your children are aware of social distancing and what it means.

Drop offs, collections and how parents can help with social distancing in school

On drop offs and collections parents and carers must only be on site for the time that has been designated to their child. If needs be, they should wait in the car or at a suitable distance from the school gates.

-Only one parent or carer should be present per family/child for drop offs and collections.

-Parents should enter and exit through the main double gate entrance – not the single gates.

-There will be no access through the bottom gate on the field – this will remain locked.

-There will be clearly marked points in the area before the playground gates where parents should stand when collecting their child(ren).

-Parents are not permitted to go past the playground gate. There will be a clearly marked area that parents shall not cross. There will be no access to the playground for parents.

-There will be no access to the school building for parents unless previously agreed. Should you need to inform of us anything then please ring in advance.

-Should a parent need to meet a teacher they should book an appointment through our Parent Liaison Officer, Mrs Care. This can be done by emailing secretary@stbryanacademy.org or through phone on 01736 810480. The meeting with the teacher is likely to be over the phone.

Our social distancing measures are based upon mutual respect and we thank everybody for their co-operation and understanding.
