On Monday 30th October a group of 10 pupils spent the day at Newquay Aerohub to watch the first, and only, public running of the Bloodhound SSC (Super Sonic Car) on British soil. The Bloodhound aims to be the first car to break 1000 mph, the biggest single jump in the land speed record ever attempted.

The aim is to inspire the next generation of engineers and inventors, so there were displays and hands on activities for everyone to have a go at, from using a bike to power lights (Jed and Peggy were our speediest peddlers) and building electric circuits, to making 'smoke' rings using flour!
