History/ Geography:

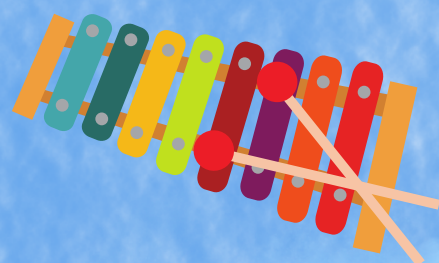
We will track Shackleton's expedition from the UK and learn about the hemispheres and polar regions. We will have a focus on how climate change is affecting Antarctica
