PORTHCURNO CLASS

World War 2 - What was Cornwall's role in the war?

It's 1939 and Britain is at war. A study of the causes and effects of the Second World War on the people of both the allied and axis powers. We will retrace the routes taken by evacuees; learn about rationing and the 'Dig for Victory' campaign; The Blitz and the significance of the Battle of Britain as a turning point in the war. Furthermore, we will find out about the impact on Cornwall and our local area.

We will learn about and create our own art work linked to WW2 scenes and based on the works of war artists.

We are lucky to be visiting the Imperial War Museum as part of our residential to London so year 5 and 6 can explore lots of primary and secondary sources linked to the war.

Our unit will end with our very own evacuee experience - more details to follow! See the Topic overview for a detailed breakdown of the terms curriculum.

PE:

READING AND HOMEWORK

Reading: We ask that children read at home to an adult at least 4 times a week (this includes free readers). This does not always need to be their school reading book: it could be a book from home, a magazine, an article on the internet or anything else that encourages your child to read and enjoy reading. Please ensure your child has their reading book and diary in school every day and that they are signed by parents.

Spelling: Spellings will be sent home on a Wednesday for a spelling quiz the following Wednesday. Please help your child to learn these words. They can also learn them on Spelling Shed

Times Tables: Please learn times tables at least 4 times a week either through TTRS, chanting or other games/ quizzes until children can recall up to 12x12 fluently and the following reading and spelling practice:
