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Head Lice Alert!

Sightings of these tiresome creatures have been reported in all classes recently; please ensure you check your child's head regularly (at least once a week) and use the recommended 'wet combing' method to eliminate any you may find. This method entails washing your child's hair, applying conditioner, then combing through carefully with a fine toothed comb. This should be repeated every 3-5 days to find any lice which may have hatched since previous combing.
