Responding to a disclosure


Remember the 5 Rs...

Receive: listen attentively, accept, be non-judgemental, TED (tell, explain, describe)

Reassure: Reassure the child that they have done the correct thing in speaking to you and hear what they are saying - **don't promise what can't be delivered and do let them know that you will have to tell Mr McDonald or Mrs K**

Respond: Tell the child what you are going to do and how you are going to do it. Ensure that the child is okay before they leave

Record: Vital facts. No opinion. When? Where? Who? What?
