During the day we will be doing some fun active maths activities in different ways to how we normally teach maths.

Bikeability is a course we run every year to help our Year 5 children become more confident in their cycling and increase their knowledge on how to safely cycle on our roads - which is incredibly important with the summer months approaching and living where we do!


