We celebrated our World Book Day the previous Monday and saw some awesome outfits. On Tuesday we were joined by the author Scott Jones, who spoke to our Key Stage 2 children about his books and inspired them as writers. The children were really enthused by him; it has been great to see so many children get stuck into his book and work so hard on their own writing. Also on Tuesday we held another Believe, Achieve, Aspire Day. We worked with the Minack Theatre to run a puppet-making workshop, drama workshop, art session and story-telling. Children loved the day and it was great to see them develop their skills in our key concepts of collaboration, teamwork, confidence and independence - as well as developing knowledge and understanding in these areas which will in turn support other areas of the curriculum.

On Monday our football team competed in the Penwith schools tournament and came second! Our hockey team have their final fixtures this week coming and we even have a dance squad ready to compete in an upcoming competition. On the sporting front, congratulations must go to Ted and Lettie who both qualified for the County Championships after some impressive running in the Penwith races. Well done to all over our cross-country runners this year who have given their all in all weather conditions!

We always aim to share examples of our learning on our Facebook and Twitter pages, as well as other updates. You may have seen a special video on some social media pages from the work our Year 6s did with the Wave Rangers Project. This was a National Lottery funded project designed to develop collaboration, confidence and awareness of the environment. Our original group of five consisting of Finn, Finley, Charlotte, Evie and Luke certainly enjoyed it; they worked with other schools in our Trust as well as organisations to help preserve the environment. They impressed so much that they got their whole year group invited to take part in a one-off session which was filmed for the National Lottery and is being used as an advert on some of their social media sites!

We were also visited by our colleagues of our Trust schools this week. Some staff from these schools spent the day with us on Tuesday visiting lessons and speaking to children. We will share the feedback with you next week, but we are very pleased with how the day went and it was great to hear them comment on the wonderful behaviour of our children around the school, how polite and well-mannered our children are - as well as many other things. I'm looking forward to sharing the feedback with you all.

On the 28th March we are holding an open afternoon. We invite you to join us in the hall from 2.10pm where you are welcome to mingle and have tea or coffee for a small donation. 


This term we have worked on the quality of our learning environment. Come and see our new look displays, library and more.


