Our original group of five consisting of Finn, Finley, Charlotte, Evie and Luke certainly enjoyed it; they worked with other schools in our Trust as well as organisations to help preserve the environment. They impressed so much that they got their whole year group invited to take part in a one-off session which was filmed for the National Lottery and is being used as an advert on some of their social media sites!

We were also visited by our colleagues of our Trust schools this week. Some staff from these schools spent the day with us on Tuesday visiting lessons and speaking to children. We will share the feedback with you next week, but we are very pleased with how the day went and it was great to hear them comment on the wonderful behaviour of our children around the school, how polite and well-mannered our children are - as well as many other things. I'm looking forward to sharing the feedback with you all.

On the 28th March we are holding an open afternoon. We invite you to join us in the hall from 2.10pm where you are welcome to mingle and have tea or coffee for a small donation. At 2.30pm we will have a short talk reviewing our year so far. After that, you are welcome to explore the school and visit our classrooms and library. 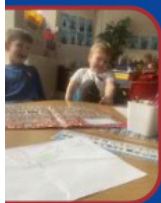

Should I keep my child off school?

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

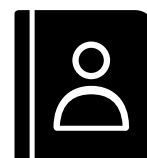
