READING AND HOMEWORK

Reading: We ask that children read at home to an adult at least 4 times a week. This does not always need to be their school reading book: it could be a book from home, a magazine, an article on the internet or anything else that encourages your child to read and enjoy reading. Please ensure your child has their reading book and diary in school every day and that they are signed by parents.

Spelling: Spellings will be sent home on a Monday for a spelling quiz the Friday. Please help your child to learn these words.

Times Tables: Please learn times tables at least 4 times a week either through TTRS, chanting or other games/ quizzes until children can recall up to 12x12 fluently.

Homework grid: The termly topic based homework grid is optional. If you choose to do one of the activities - please bring it to school to share with the class.

We are committed to driving our attendance continuously upward. It goes without saying, but the more that your child is in school, the more opportunity they have to learn and progress in all areas.
